

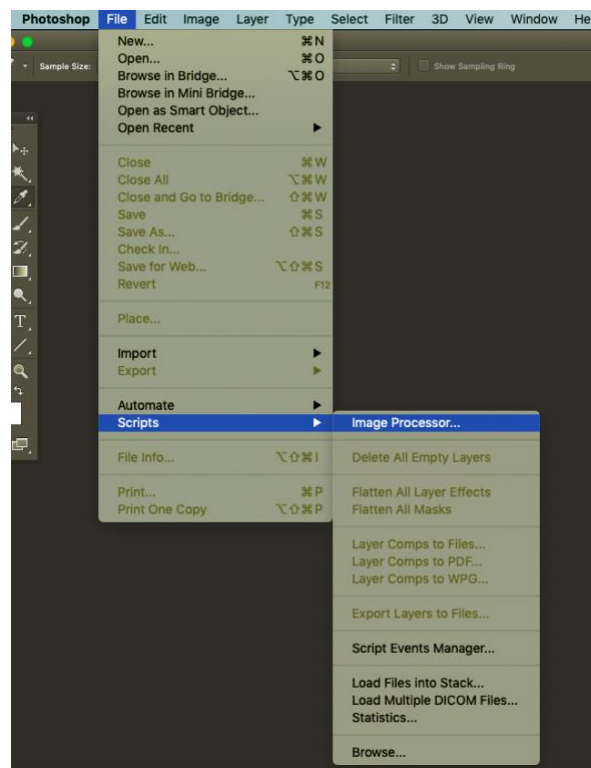
## Sizing Images to Upload to WordPress

While high resolution files are always better for printing, many Internet applications have a size limitation for what you can upload. Therefore you will need to resize everything that you post to WordPress. Here is an easy way to do this:

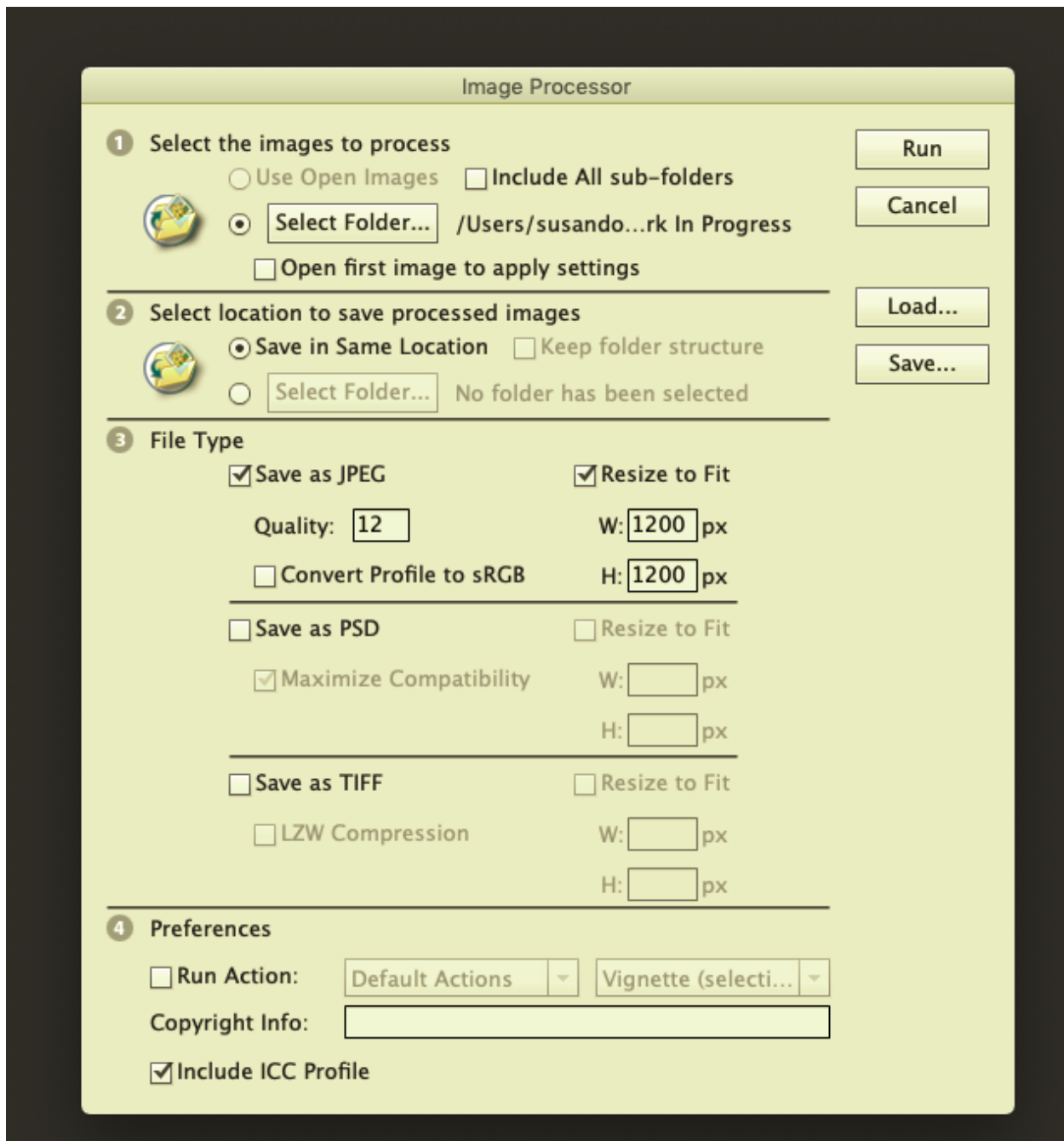
Step 1. Put all the images you want to upload to WordPress into a single folder. Label the folder with the category you will be using for your blog post (e.g. Assignment #1 Work In Progress). This will help keep you organized.

Step 2. Open Photoshop.

Step 3. Open the Image Processor:



Step 4: Select the folder that you created. Choose to save the resized images into the same location (it won't overwrite your originals, but will create a subfolder with your resized images automatically). Choose to save as jpeg, quality 12, and resize to max. 1200 width and 1200 height:



Step 5. Click Run. Each image will open automatically in Photoshop, will resize automatically, and will be saved in a subfolder within your original folder. Each image will be sized so that the longest height or width measures 1200 pixels. Use these smaller files for posting to the Internet, and keep your high resolution images for printing.
